****Please be sure to bring completed & signed Emergency Card on your FIRST DAY of band camp; students will NOT be allowed to participate in band camp without it.**** Additionally, please be sure to drink plenty of water the day before and get plenty of sleep the night before Band Camp.

July 26-27, 9:00am-12:00pm – Rookie and Leadership Camp

All freshmen and first year marching band students should plan to attend. This 2-day camp will allow new students to work with techs and student leaders on marching basics in a smaller group with more concentrated attention in preparation for the start of full band camp on Monday, July 30th. Wind instrument checkout will also be available to those students who wish to do so.

What to Wear

- **Black Binder with 15 Sheet Protectors for your music and a Pencil**
- **Sweat Towel, Deodorant and Clean T-shirt to change at lunchtime, as needed**
- **Inhalers or Other Medications, as needed**
- **Lunch that does not need to be refrigerated** – Lunches should be stowed along with personal items in the band room until lunchtime. *For safety reasons, it is highly recommended that students DO NOT leave campus for lunch.* If you forget your lunch or otherwise choose to take advantage of it, FUSD provides free lunches in the Edison cafetorium until 1:00pm daily.
